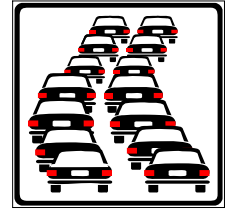

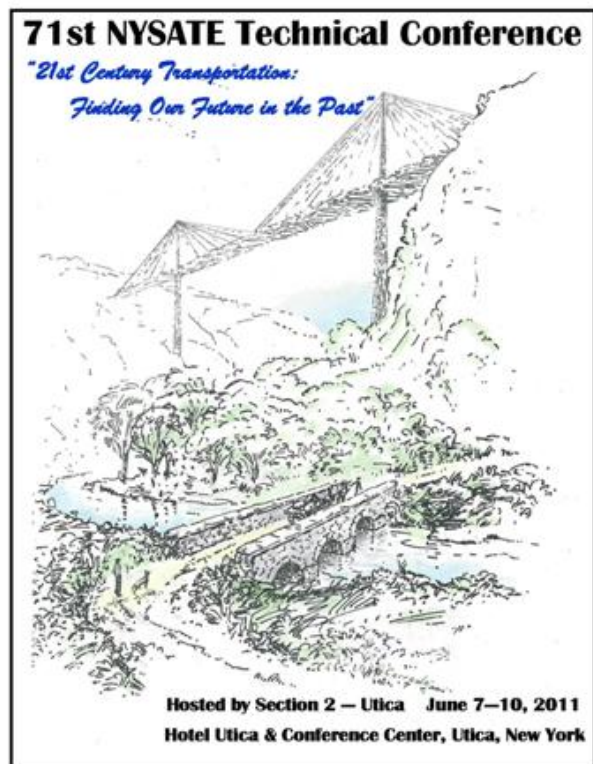
Holiday Card

NYSATE Scholarships

Applications are available for the NYSATE Section 10 Members/Dependents Scholarship Program for 2011. Please contact Tahir Qureshi, Priscilla Ortiz, Karen Taylor, Margaret Conklin (all from Region 10), Adam Levine (Region 11), or log onto the NYSATE website under Section10 News (www.nysate.org) for applications.

Dependent scholarships are available for children/wards of a member (active, affiliated, associate, or adjunct) of NYSATE in this local section who has an unbroken membership for a period of two years preceding the application for scholarship. Membership must be paid up during the tenure of the scholarship. In addition, children of a deceased member who would have been eligible if the parent were living are eligible. This program is for high school seniors or graduates under the age of 25 enrolled in an accredited college for the fall 2011 semester. Selection will be based on scholastic achievements, community involvement, and other merits.

In addition, up to ten \$100 college scholarships are given to NYSATE Section 10 members for

the 2011/2012 scholastic year to be used by the recipient at an accredited school for engineering or transportation related studies. To qualify you must be a member (active, affiliated, associate, or adjunct) of NYSATE in this local section who has an unbroken membership for a period of two years preceding the application for scholarship and keep your membership paid up during the tenure of the scholarship. Selection will be by lottery.

All applications must be submitted to the NYSATE screening committee no later than Tuesday May 31, 2011.

Republic Airport Tour

Section 10 is planning a tour of Republic Airport for Friday, June 24. Republic is the only airport that is owned and operated by the DOT. It is located in East Farmingdale, right along NY110 and is the third busiest airport in New York State. You should be able to guess the two busiest!

The airport is a general aviation facility, which means there is no commercial service from the airport. The airport primarily serves recreational and business flying as well as a great amount of flight training.

The airport is also the home of the American Airpower Museum, which has numerous World War II aircraft that still fly.

While plans for the visit are still be finalized, the tour will encompass a tour of the main terminal including discussion on the issues the airport must deal with on a daily basis, a visit to the American Airpower Museum to see the aircraft and displays that museum has to recognize the sacrifices made by the men and women of this country during WWII, and possibly a visit to a corporate hangar to see the latest in business jets

and discuss the reasons for traveling by private jet.

Bring Your Future To Work

Regions 10 and 11 will be celebrating Bring Your Future to Work. NYSATE Section 10 will be donating \$25 to each region to help defray the cost of food or give-aways for participating children.

DEPENDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - 2011

NEW YORK STATE ASSOCIATION OF TRANSPORTATION ENGINEERS SECTION 10

1. The number of scholarships and the dollar amount shall be based on funds received on Regional Level.
2. Will be used by the recipient at an accredited school of his or her choice.
3. Will be paid directly to the individual for payment of tuition or other bona fide school charges.
4. May be canceled if deemed advisable by a majority of the members of the N.Y.S.A.T.E. Board of Directors voting at an official meeting. The Association reserves the right to cancel the program without prior notification.

Candidates for Scholarship

1. Must be a child / ward of a member (active, affiliated, associate, or adjunct) of NYSATE in this local section. Such member shall be in good standing and have an unbroken membership for a period of two years preceding the application for scholarship, and keep their membership paid up during the tenure of the scholarship; or a child of a deceased member who would have been eligible if the parent were living.
2. Must be a High School Senior or Graduate under the age of 25 enrolled in an accredited college at the time of application.
3. Must submit their application to the local N.Y.S.A.T.E. Screening Committee no later than Tuesday May 31, 2011.
4. A given dependent applicant may receive up to a maximum of 4 annual scholarships.
5. **SAT and ACT scores and complete transcripts must be submitted even if currently in college** (copies are acceptable).
6. The attached form must be completely filled out. You may attach additional sheets, if necessary.
